#### Siem Reap

After breakfast: Visit Banteay Srei, the unique and delicate architecture in the relics of the Angkor and famous for the splendid color and reliefs. It is known as the treasure of Angkor art. Banteay Srei means the castle of women, which was assumed to be built by women. Visit Angkor Wat, the most mysterious site of the world's seven wonders. Entitled as "the carved paradise" in the archaeological field, it is the relics of the civilization of Angkor Empire. Visit South Gate and Angkor Thom, where there are hundreds of historical relics which will be in line with your imagination of adventure. You could visit Bayon Temple, as well as Elephant Terrace and Prasat Suor Prat which was built in Jayavarman VII period. Visit Ta Prohm which has been covered by old trees since 12th century. You will be amazed by the magic power of nature here. It is the site where the film Tomb Raider was shot.

After lunch: visit Moat bridge, Long Corridor, Preah Poan and Echo Hall.

After breakfast: Visit Preah Ang Chek Preah Ang Chorm, where the King and Prime Minister comes every year for praying. Enjoy the 1-hour Cambodian massage. Take the flight to Bangkok.

### Bangkok - Pattaya

After breakfast: Visit the Bangkok Grand Palace, where there are the best architectures, paintings, carves and decoration art of Thailand. Wat Phra Kaew is close to the Grand Palace. It is the only temple in Thailand with no monk but enshrining the Jade Budda Statue, which is the national treasure of Thailand. Visit Wat Arun temple, where there are five identical pagodas, one big and four small. The spires of pagodas are colorful and decorated with intricate carvings and inlaid with various colored ceramic pieces, glass and shells. It is also known as the "Eiffel Tower of Thailand". Drive to Pattaya, watch Alcazar Show, it's an experience that transports you into a world of vibrant costumes, dramatic performances, and breathtaking stage designs.

After breakfast: Take the speedboat to Coral Island and enjoy various aquatic games (fees are not included in the package price). Visit Sanctuary of Truth. It is a gigantic wooden construction constituting of rosewood and teakwood in a delicate craftsmanship with wedges and latches. It fully presents the glorious style of Bangkok Dynasty.
